## Travelling to Clayton campus and parking on-site

Clayton campus is located on the corner of Wellington Road and Princes Highway, 20 km from Melbourne's city centre.

### Travelling to Clayton campus

**By car:** the trip will take about 30 minutes from the city centre along the Monash Freeway. From Melbourne airport the trip takes 45 minutes. (Melways map ref. 70 G10)

**By train:** to get to Clayton campus by public transport, take any of the Dandenong, Pakenham or Cranbourne line trains to Huntingdale station then catch a bus to the campus. Buses leave the station for Clayton campus every 15-20 minutes.

### Parking at Clayton campus

Most Monash parking during teaching Semesters is co-ordinated through the acquisition of blue and red permits. These are only available to Monash students and staff.

For MCEM visitors, an all day yellow parking permit can be borrowed from Penelope Love or Madeleine Einsiedel at the MCEM general office. The closest yellow parking bays are located at the W2 Parking Lot – Clayton Campus Map ref. C1. If all yellow parking bays are taken, visitors with a yellow permit can also park in any blue bay, the closest to MCEM is the high rise carpark, Building 80, Clayton Campus Map ref. B2.

Alternatively, all day ticket parking is available for \$6.00 per day on the uppermost level of the high rise carpark located close to MCEM (Building 80, Clayton Campus Map ref. B2)

Parking without a permit is available in the blue, red and yellow zones after 5pm on weekdays and all weekend.
